

## \*\*\* LKOC BEAUTIFICATION PROJECTS IN KAILUA \*\*\*

The Lani-Kailua Outdoor Circle (LKOC) has been beautifying our public spaces in Kailua since 1948!

### EXAMPLES OF LKOC PROJECTS FUNDED BY TOWN PARTY PROCEEDS

**1994 – present** ~ With proceeds from our first Town Party, LKOC designed and installed the landscaping at **Alala Point** overlooking Kailua Beach, from the boat ramp to the monument and in the upper and lower mauka parking lots. Since **1999**, we have provided the landscape maintenance for the multi-acre area. In **2019**, we performed a major landscape refurbishment of the upper mauka parking lot and installed a new lawn and perimeter hedging.

KAILUA INTERMEDIATE

**2002, 2004** ~ LKOC planted Royal Poincianas at **Kailua Intermediate School** and Monkeypods at Lanikai Elementary School (now Ka'ohao Charter School).

**2007** ~ In partnership with the City and County of Honolulu, LKOC spearheaded the planting of Shower and Narra trees in the median on **Mokapu Road** between Kalaheo Avenue and the Marine Corp Base Hawaii entrance.

PALI PALMS

**2010 – present** ~ LKOC designed and installed the landscaping at the traffic triangles at either end of Kalaheo Avenue, one at **Pali Palms** and the other at **Kalapawai**, and has been paying for the on-going professional maintenance of those plantings. In **2020**, we refurbished the landscaping at Pali Palms Triangle. Note that LKOC volunteers planted the iconic Kalapawai Triangle banyan in **1954**.

**2020** ~ LKOC spearheaded a C&C street tree replanting project on **Oneawa Street**, from Kuulei Road to Kawainui Street, where Silver Trumpet and White Tecoma trees were planted.

**2023** ~ LKOC planted a heliotrope at HECO substation on Kainalu Drive.

### LOOKING BACK...HOW OUR STREETS AND PARKS HAVE BEEN ENHANCED BY LKOC



Kailua Road Median  
Trees Planted 1949

**1949** ~ LKOC planted dozens of Tecoma trees on the **Kailua Road** median entering central Kailua. In **1950**, a major roadway upgrade replaced these with Kamani trees. Since **2000**, LKOC has funded the landscape maintenance of the median down to Kuulei Road.

**1957** ~ LKOC collaborated to plant coconut trees in the **Kainui Drive** central median.

**1950s, 1960s** ~ LKOC planted hundreds of street trees on Oneawa, Uluniu, Maluniu, Kainehe, Kihapai, and Hoolai streets, as well as on school grounds, parks and neighborhoods and in newly developed Enchanted Lake.

**1980** ~ LKOC designed and installed the tree-filled **Aikahi Triangle Park**.
